What is family Violence?

- Violent behaviour
- ▶ Threatening behaviour
- Controlling behaviour
- By an past or present family member
- Coerces another family member or makes them fearful

Who is family?

- Present or past partners
- Parents
- Step parents
- Siblings
- Carers
- Grandparents
- Uncles and Aunts
- Others who are household members

What can family violence encompass?

- ▶ Intimate partner violence
- Child abuse
- ▶ Elder abuse
- Adolescent violence towards parents

What types of abuse can occur?

- Physical abuse
- Sexual abuse
- ▶ Emotional and psychological abuse
- ▶ Neglect
- ▶ Economic abuse
- Spiritual abuse

What do primary health care professionals see?



Catherine's story

- ► Catherine is 74,
- ▶ She is a former teacher,
- Full time caregiver for her husband John who 79,
- John has dementia,
- Catherine finds him is difficult to manage because of his irritability and confusion,
- She sometimes forgets to give him his medication.

Is this abuse?

- ► Mhàs
- ► Why not?



What if

- Catherine intentionally withheld medication?
- ▶ John's room was unkept and dirty?
- ▶ Does this change your thinking?



The Take Home Message

- Think about family violence as a possibility;
- ▶ BE PREPARED to respond;
- ▶ Be non-judgemental;
- Accept uncertainty, enquire about risk and monitor carefully;
- ▶ Duty of care.
